Course Description:

Hazardous Waste Management for Small Quantity Generators(SQGs): This training program provides a general understanding of the basics of hazardous waste management for SQGs. The program covers waste identification, container and tank management requirements, and central and satellite accumulation.

****This class is offered in AM and PM****

SPCC Plans for APSA Sites: This course highlights Aboveground Petroleum Storage Act (APSA) statutes for facilities that store >1,320 gallons of petroleum products (fuels, oils, solvents, etc.) in aboveground storage tanks. The course provides an overview of regulated facilities and materials, Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) Plans, recordkeeping, and training requirements.

****This class is only offered as a PM class****

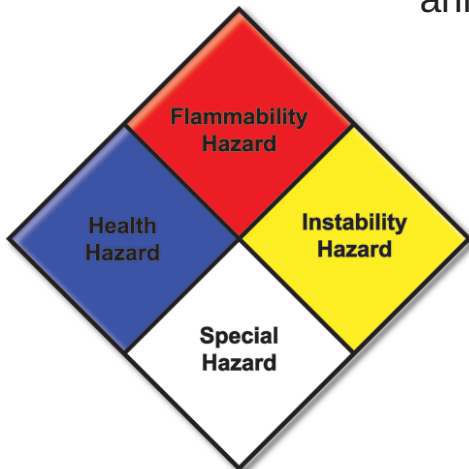
Hazardous Materials Business Plans (HMBP) & CERS / eHazMat Portal: This program covers completion, submittal, and employee training requirements for facilities that are required to prepare a Hazardous Materials Business Plan because they store hazardous materials at their facility. The training covers navigation and use of the California Environmental Reporting System (CERS) and Fresno County's Portal (eHazMat).
